

## **REGISTER FOR NISIS Autumn School 2019!**

From Monday 28 until Thursday 31 October 2019, the NISIS Autumn School will be held at Utrecht University. The theme of this year's Autumn School is 'Islamic and Middle Eastern Studies in the Digital Age'.

PhD candidates, research master students and advanced MA students, whose research focuses on the study of Muslims, Muslim societies and Islam in the broadest sense of the word, are invited to enrol, subject to review by the Autumn School's organizers.

To register, upload the necessary information (see below) on the NISIS website before **Monday 16 September 2019, 09.00 hrs (CET)**. Incomplete or delayed registrations will not be taken into consideration.

When registering, please include the following:

- a title and an abstract of your presentation (250 words max)\*. Presentations should be related to the theme of the Autumn School
- a short biography (50 words max., in third person)\*

\*If your participation is confirmed, this information will be used in the program booklet.

## Please note the following:

- 1. **NISIS junior members automatically qualify for participation**, but DO need to register by sending in a title, an abstract and a short biography (see requirements above).
- 2. The number of people who can be admitted to the NISIS Autumn School is limited.
- 3. Lunches and a conference dinner will be included in the programme for those participants who are enrolled in a Dutch university or the KU Leuven. All other costs are for your own expenses.
- 4. For those PhD candidates who are not enrolled in a Dutch university or the KU Leuven, we ask a fee of €60 (€30 lunch & coffee for four days, €30 conference dinner) to cover the expenses. Please contact Dorieke Molenaar (d.molenaar@uu.nl) for more information.

If you participate in the Autumn School you can obtain 3 EC if you:

- read the prescribed literature in advance, you will be asked to reflect on the literature during one of the workshops;
- hand in at least one question related to each article;
- give a presentation in one of the workshops and act as discussant for the presentation of one of the other participants.

## For an additional 2 EC:

• complete an assignment during the workshop on Wednesday and afterwards.
